Pitcher plants can grow in soggy soil with the water level in the saucer as deep as 1/2 the pot, but most carnivorous plants prefer damp to wet soil, so keep the water at about 1/4 inch and refill as soon as it is nearly gone.

Water It is vitally important that you only water carnivorous plants with rain, distilled, or reverse osmosis water. Tap water contains detrimental chemicals and minerals. Most carnivores are bog plants and therefore prefer consistent moisture.
